DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH PROVIDES HOLIDAY CLOSURE **RESOURCES AND INFORMATION**

The Mohawk Council of Akwesasne's (MCA) Department of Health is providing the community with resources and information for services during MCA's holiday closure from April 15th - April 18th. Most of MCA's programs will be closed, with the exception of 24-hour facilities. The Ahkwesahsne Mohawk Board of Education (AMBE) schools and services will also be closed for the holiday weekend during this time.
