You are invited to submit an application to represent **Mohawk Council of Akwesasne** on the Ontario First Nations regional 2SLGBTQQIA+ Council ("2S+ Council"). *This is a volunteer position.*

The 2S+ Council is a new permanent Entity within the Charter of the Chiefs of Ontario. The Council incorporates 2SLGBTQQIA+ voices and perspectives at the regional decision-making level on issues affecting First Nations communities in Ontario. The Council will work to promote community awareness and acceptance of diversity in gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, and spiritual identity.

The 2S+ Council is to be comprised of one official representative from each Political Territorial Organization (Anishinabek Nation, the Association of Iroquois and Allied Indians, Nishnawbe Aski Nation, and Grand Council Treaty #3) and from the Mohawk Council of Akwesasne, Mushkegowuk Tribal Council, Six Nations of the Grand River, and Independent First Nations. Representatives can be community members, Chiefs, Councillors, or Technicians. *Selection is not based on holding an elected position.*

In addition to the official representative, a secondary representative may be selected to act as an alternate or may attend in support of the official representative.
